## Commemoration of the arrival of the first Polish craftsmen in Jamestown, VA Program Schedule – October 1, 2008

- 3:00pm Guests arrive at Jamestown Settlement – drive by Glasshouse
- 3:15pm Guests are divided into groups and will be escorted to the outdoor interpretive areas—Powhatan Indian Village, James Fort, Riverfront Discovery Area and the recreated ships. Upon completing outdoor tour, groups move indoors to the museum building.
- For those who may not wish to take the outside tour, an optional indoor tour will be available to include viewing of the 1607: A Nation Takes Root film, in-depth permanent galleries and the John White exhibit tour.
- 4:15pm After viewing the permanent galleries, guests will be lead upstairs to the John White exhibit.
- 5:00pm Break—restrooms, gift shop, café
- 5:30pm Guests are guided outdoors to the Quadricentennial Plaza for wreath-laying ceremony at the plaque followed by speeches and selections by the Polish Singers Alliance of America combined chorus.
- 6:20pm Guests move indoors for remainder of formal program followed by reception. Advance reservations required – tickets not available at the door!
- 8:30pm Depart for Hotel.
