Dear Rowny Family,

On behalf of the Polish American Congress (PAC), I would like to express my deepest condolences to you upon the death of Lieutenant General Edward L. Rowny, an exemplary American and Polish patriot.

General Rowny established the American Polish Advisory Council, to persuade both official and public opinion that a strong and sovereign Poland protects United States security interests, and promotes American democratic values in East Central Europe. This also is the core mission of the Polish American Congress. For many years, two officers of the Polish American Congress, the late Dr. Susanne Lotarski and Dean Anthony T. Bajdek served on the Board of Trustees of this organization.

I am committed to working to achieve this goal in the political context of Kremlin revanchism. This is the most fitting tribute to General Rowny's life and work.

I have fond memories of the General and I admired him greatly. My health prevents me from going to the General's funeral on January 27. Mr. John Czop, Director of Policy Planning at the PAC National Office in Washington, will represent me, as well as the Polish American Congress at the funeral.
